



Club professional Åke Bergkvist is one of several professionals who started playing at the Flommen club, next door to Falsterbo GK.

Eric Ericsson won the national over 75 amateur title in 2008, his 68th season. He was Professional at Örebro GK for 30 years and played in the World Cup in 1972.

He has invented teaching aids, such as the flail club (pictured left) and a swing aid that uses a laser beam mounted on the top of the grip to guide the pupil in the backswing. The idea is to watch how the laser light moves on the ground in front of the player's feet.
